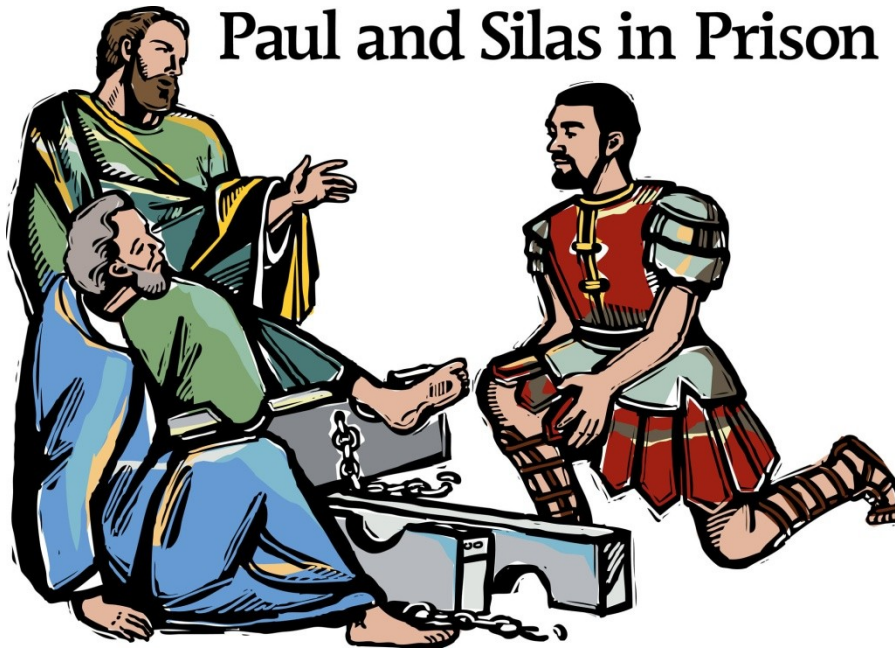

Persecuted Church –Ethiopia

Special Report – Voice of Martyrs

Ethiopian Christians who faithfully proclaim the gospel, plant churches and train biblical disciples have faced opposition for centuries, and persecution has intensified in the last few years.



- **Oromo Islamic Extremists in the South** – Although only one-third of the total population of Ethiopia is Muslim in the southern Oromo region about 60% are Muslim and have become very violent in recent years. There have been devastating attacks on Christians, who lose their homes, businesses, church buildings and are beaten and killed. But this has not deterred them from sharing the gospel.
- **Traditional Christians in the North** – Although nearly 60 percent of Ethiopians identify as Christians, only about 20 percent are biblical in faith. Most are part of the Ethiopian Orthodox Church (EOC) and their teachings are vastly different from the biblical Christians. As biblical Christians share the gospel and plant churches, the EOC members have carried out violent attacks against them.
- **Somali Islamic Nationalists in the East** – Ethiopia has nearly 5 million Islamic Muslims living in Ethiopia. As a result, those who leave Islam to follow Christ are considered as betraying their national identity. They are beaten, ostracized and sometimes killed.

Although Christians in Ethiopia face increased persecution from multiple sources, they are determined to continue sharing the gospel, loving their enemies, and advancing God's kingdom. Pray that their bold, steadfast faith leads to the gospel's

spread throughout the Ethiopia and into other countries in the Horn of Africa and beyond.

World, National, and State Concerns

Pray for **protection**, and for **containment** of the **Corona virus (COVID-19)**.

Pray for our **nation's leaders**, that they would have **wisdom** in how to deal with the virus. Pray for **medical professionals**, that God would guide and protect them as they treat those affected.

Pray for our brothers and sisters whose **businesses** and **job stability** might be affected. Pray especially for those who are the most **vulnerable** to the effects of the virus.

Pray earnestly for a **revival in this land**, that Christians will boldly take a stand for their Christian beliefs. Pray that those who attempt to impose restrictions on us that are contrary to the Law of God are stopped.
