Excerpts from Open Doors 11/10/2020 and 11/12/2020

“Since COVID-19 struck, it has been hard to provide for my family. Muslim neighbors would tell my children,

‘Kafir’ (“infidel”) you need Allah. It was tempting to go back to Islam just for the sake of food.”

—Aisha, a Christian mother in Kenya

We’ve wrestled with the corona virus pandemic here in the United States, but for many of our persecuted sisters and brothers—**it’s a life-or-death struggle.**

For Christians like Muluken and his wife Iris in Ethiopia, just getting food to survive and feed their children is a daily battle. When they left Islam to follow Jesus, Muluken lost his job—and they have been denied access to government relief because of their faith.

The couple’s church tried to help them—but they, too, have struggled during the COVID-19 lockdown. It’s a situation we see all over the world.

When Christians like Muluken and Iris are denied government aid because they follow Jesus: that’s persecution.

World, National, and State Concerns

Pray especially for those who are the most **vulnerable** to the effects of the virus.


Pray for **President Donald Trump** as he continues his four-year term of office. These are critical days for our nation.
